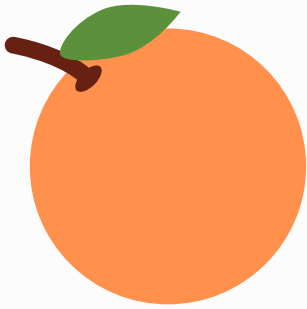
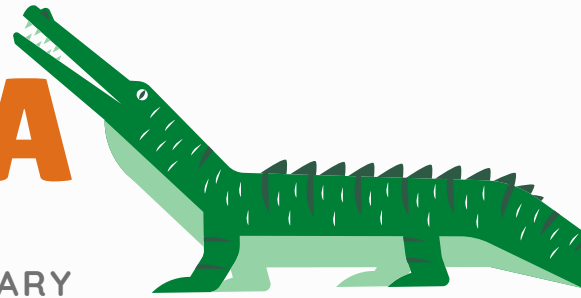

ALLIGATOR TAIL

Supplies Included:

One long piece of green paper

Supplies not included:

Pencil

Scissors

Glue

Instructions:

1. Fold the paper in half long ways.
2. Draw a line from the top outside edge to the folded edge at the bottom of the paper.
3. Cut along the line.
4. Make triangle spikes from the extra green paper and glue them along the outside edges of the triangle.
5. Tape, safety pin, or tuck the tail into the back of your pants and pretend to be an alligator.
