



## PATRON TIPS: E-CARD ACCESS

- 1. Visit www.myhlc.org
- 2. On the right side of the screen, it says "Check Your Account" /
- 3. Click the "Check Your Account" link
- 4. On the right side of the screen, it says "Log in to Your Account"
- 5. In the box under the word "Barcode," type in your library card number with NO spaces. It should start with 2341
- 6. In the box under the word "Pin," type in the pin/password that you set up at registration. If you are unsure, try the last 4 digits of your library card number (again, no spaces). If that doesn't work, call 863-402-6716.
- 7. Click Log In
- 8. On the left side of the screen, click the button that says "view your ecard"
- 9. A pop-up will appear with your name and library card number, as well as a barcode.
- 10. Now as long as you can access your library account, you will have your library card with you!
