

Reading logs will encourage kids and teens to read at least twenty minutes a day for five days each week. Students will track their reading to meet weekly goals. When kids complete their goal each week, they can visit the library to get a sticker, treasure box prize, and raffle ticket to put towards one of our summer reading prizes! Goals can be redeemed once per week.

Twenty minutes of reading daily has been shown to help with vocabulary, comprehension, and language skills, as well as developing empathy, critical thinking skills, and creativity.

Adults Reading Log

All Summer

We want to encourage the adults in our community to read, too! Adults can sign up for a reading log and complete daily reading challenges of twenty minutes a day. Adults who complete their weekly challenge will receive a raffle ticket to put towards one of our prizes, such as a gardening set, art kit, and other prizes.

Reading daily for adults has many benefits, including reducing stress and improve focus and memory. It has even been shown to stimulate brain activity and improve quality of sleep.



Raffle Prizes

Whenever you complete a weekly reading goal or attend Summer Reading Programming, you will receive a raffle ticket to put towards the prize of your choice. Prizes will include gift baskets, Squishmallows, Lego sets, and more.



Treasure Box and Stickers

The treasure box is back! Every time that a child checks off their weekly reading goal at the front desk or attends programming, they will be able to pick a prize from the treasure box and a sticker.

Tumblers

When you sign up to participate in the reading log, you will receive a tumbler. Decorate your tumbler with the stickers you collect throughout summer programming!
