

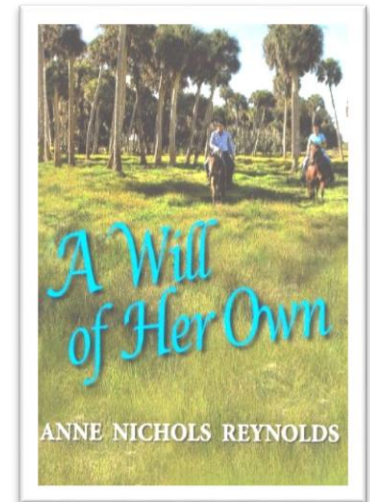
**LOCAL AUTHOR VISITS THE SEBRING LIBRARY
