Census 2020

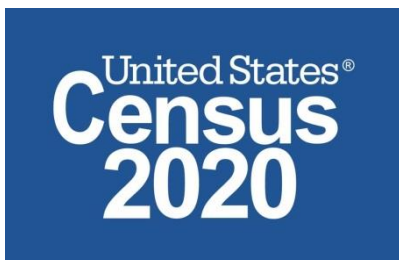
The U.S. Census is still happening as scheduled and you will be receiving a notice in the mail. The Census matters now more than ever as our County receives needed funds for EVERY PERSON counted that pays for schools, roads, emergency, and other vital services provided by government funds.

If you do not have internet, you can call the Okeechobee Library to fill out the form over the phone at 863-763-3536. Just have your unique 12-digit ID ready (found on your letter). Your privacy will still be secure.

Holds

We will still be providing limited holds but this process will be a bit different from usual. Please see below for more details:

- Please place holds online. We are NOT able to take hold requests over the phone at the moment.
- Please check your account for proper phone contact information.
- We will fill requests with items available at our location only. Please allow at least 24 - 48 hours for staff to fill hold.
- Patrons will receive a phone call when hold is filled. If you had a hold from before the Library's closing you will be contacted shortly.
- You will be given a choice of dates and times to come pick up your holds from the Library's gated back entrance.
