Narwhal-Unicorn of the Sea Supplies included:

Gray paper plate White piece of paper **Supplies from home:**

Glue Scissors Black marker

Instructions:

- 1. To make Narwhal's body, cut the 'V' lines on the paper plate to make a 'V' shape out of your paper plate. Keep the extra parts for the other parts of Narwhal.
- 2. Make the flippers by cutting the extra part with a line down the middle in half.
- 3. Cut out the heart shape from the other extra part to make the tail.
- 4. Glue the flippers to the side of Narwhal's body. Glue the tail to the point at the bottom.
- 5.Cut out the horn from the white paper, and glue it to the top of Narwhal's head.
- 6.Draw on Narwhal's eyes, happy smile, and lines on the horn.
